The program requires 30 credits and a comprehensive examination. ***The program may be completed in three semesters plus one summer term if students follow the designated sequence. Some courses will be available online.***

- Project Planning and Resource Management
- Project Cost, Value, and Financial Management
- Project Execution, Risk and Quality Management
- Project Procurement Management in Public and Private Sectors

Choose 3 courses from a listing of over 40 courses to integrate project management skills in a specific subject area from *Architecture, Art, Business, City and Regional Planning, Civil Engineering, Computer Science, Electrical Engineering, Industrial Engineering, Information Technology, Science, and Transportation.*

A capstone course allows students to focus on a project from the work environment through initiating, planning, execution, monitoring and controlling, and closing.
